



- NIH Clinical Center







## Things You and Your Constituents Need to Know Research Participation at the NIMH

**Join A Study**

Participate in research to help transform the understanding and treatment of depression.

**First Steps to Participate:**

- 1. Call our study database
- 2. Ask About Your Eligibility
- 3. Consent to Be Involved

**Important Information:**

Participation in this study requires a commitment of up to 12 weeks at the NIH Clinical Center Research Unit. Participants will receive: screening of current depression symptoms, a telephone interview to determine eligibility, a telephone interview to obtain informed consent, and follow-up visits.

Participants will be required to keep a diary of their mood and activities for 1 week. These diary entries may require participants to access the Internet to log in and out of the study system. These arrangements and compensation are included.
